

Groupees LLC Privacy Policy

Effective Date: September 1, 2014

Your privacy matters to us, so Groupees LLC ("Groupees", "we", "us" or "our") has created the following Privacy Policy to let users of groupees.com or Groupee's mobile application (individually and collectively, the "Service"), know what information we collect when you visit the Service, why we collect it, and how it is used. This Privacy Policy explains the data collection and use practices of the Service; it does not apply to other online or offline Groupees sites, products or services. The terms "you," "your," and "yours" refer to the customer/purchaser utilizing our Service. This Privacy Policy is governed by Groupees [Terms and Conditions](#). By using the Service, you consent to the data practices prescribed in this Privacy Policy. We may periodically make changes to this Privacy Policy that we will include on this page. It is your responsibility to review this Privacy Policy and remain informed about any changes to it, so we encourage you to visit this page often. If a material change is made to this Privacy Policy, then Groupees will post a notice on groupees.com.

What Information Is Collected?

"Personal Information" means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, home or other physical address, an email address, phone number or other contact information, whether at work or at home. Groupees may collect the following Personally Identifiable Information from you when you use our Service: your email address, Facebook login, Twitter login or Steam login, and payment confirmation details from any payments you make to supported payment services such as Paypal, Google, Amazon and Bitcoin. If you correspond with us by email or through the Service, we may retain the content of your messages, your email address and our responses.

Groupees also automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, cookie information, and the page you request. Our Service uses Google Analytics to help us learn about who visits our site and what pages are being viewed. You can choose not to provide us with certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of some of our features.

When you visit the Service, we may send one or more cookies - a small text file containing a string of alphanumeric characters - to your computer that uniquely identifies your browser and lets Groupees help you log in faster and enhance your navigation through the Service. A cookie may also convey information about how you browse the Service to us. A cookie does not collect personal information

about you. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the Service. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser's directions. A session cookie is temporary and disappears after you close your browser. You can reset your web browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some features of the Service may not function properly if the ability to accept cookies is disabled.

How Is Such Information Used?

We use your Personal Information to provide you the services offered on our Service. Groupees may use your email address to email you a link to your download page and to notify you of future Groupees promotions if the "Notify me about future Groupees promotions" checkbox is checked. Groupees may also use your Personal Information in order to contact you if you request customer or technical support.

Groupees uses the data you enter on the Service, such as the price you enter and the option to include charity, to make sure that your contributions go to the right places. Groupees uses browser data like which operating system you are using to improve the Service's user experience by making your download page default to the game builds corresponding to your current operating system.

We use cookies to improve our Service and make it easier to use. Cookies permit us to recognize users and avoid repetitive requests for the same information. Cookies from our Service cannot be read by other sites. Most browsers will accept cookies until you change your browser settings to refuse them.

We may use certain information about you internally for purposes such as analyzing how the Service is used, diagnosing service or technical problems, maintaining security, and personalizing content.

We may make your Personal Information non-personally identifiable by either combining it with information about other users (aggregating your Personal Information with information about other users), or by removing characteristics (such as your name or email address) that make the information personally identifiable. This process is known as de-personalizing your information. You grant us a royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable and fully transferable right and license to use your Personal Information in connection with the creation and development of analytical and statistical analysis tools relating to the use of the customer data we collect on the Site (the "Analytical Data"). We may make any commercial use of the Analytical Data, including without limitation, sharing the Analytical Data with third parties.

Is The Information Shared or Disclosed?

Groupees does not sell or share the information it collects through the Service except as described in this Privacy Policy. Information collected from you is

disclosed and used to complete and support your purchases from and use of the GroupeesService and to comply with any requirements of law. For example, we may disclose information to third party payment processors. We may also disclose information to third party social networks at your direction, e.g. when you "tweet" or "like" something on the Service.

From time to time, we may run contests, special offers, or other events or activities ("Events") on the Service together with a third party partner. If you provide information to such third parties, you give them permission to use it for the purpose of that Event and any other use that you approve. We cannot control third parties' use of your information. If you do not want your information to be collected by or shared with a third party, you can choose not to participate in these Events.

Groupees may disclose Personal Information if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (1) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Groupees or the Service; (2) protect and defend the rights or property of Groupees; or (3) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Groupees, its web sites or the public. If Groupees or substantially all of its assets are acquired, or in the unlikely event that Groupees goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of Groupees may continue to use your Personal Information as set forth in this policy.

Please be aware that this Privacy Policy and the choices you make on the Service will not necessarily apply to Personal Information you may have provided to Groupees in the context of other, separately operated, Groupees products or services.

The Security of Your Information.

The Personal Information that you provide to us is stored on servers that are located in secured facilities and protected by protocols and procedures designed to ensure the security of such information. In addition, Groupees employees and agents who have access to your personal information are trained in the maintenance and security of that information. However, no server, computer or communications network or system, or data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect user information, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us or through the use of the Service and you acknowledge and agree that you provide such information and engage in such transmissions at your own

risk. Once we receive a transmission from you, we will endeavor to maintain its security on our systems.

International Transfers

Personal information collected on the Service may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which Groupees or its affiliates, subsidiaries or agents maintain facilities, and by using the Service, you consent to any such transfer of information outside of your country.

Children.

Groupees will not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from any person age 13 and under. Groupees encourages parents to instruct their children to never give out personal information when online. Parents who are concerned about the transfer of personal information from their children may contact us at support@groupees.com to obtain a record of any information held by Groupees and have it removed at their request.

Governing Law

This Privacy Policy is governed by, and construed under, the laws of the United States of America and the law of the State of Oregon, excluding its choice of law provisions.

Dispute Resolution Outside The European Union

If you are a resident of any country not a current member of the European Union, you agree that should any dispute or claim arise out of, or relate to, this Policy (“Claim”), you will attempt in good faith to negotiate a written resolution of the Claim directly with us. You agree that if the matter remains unresolved for thirty (30) days after one party has provided written notice of the Claim to the other party, all parties shall join in mediation services in Portland, Oregon with a mutually agreed mediator in an attempt to resolve the dispute. Should you file any arbitration claims, or any administrative or legal actions without first having attempted to resolve the matter by mediation, then you agree that you will not be entitled to recover attorneys’ fees, even if you would otherwise be entitled to them.

Please note that this informal resolution procedure does not suspend any statutory limitation periods applicable to the bringing of a Claim.
